



On March, 2nd 2017, Dr. Natthapoj Vincent Trakulphadetkrai, Lecturer in Primary Mathematics Education at the University of Reading, was interviewed by Paul Kennedy, one of the BBC Radio Berkshire hosts about the launch of his research project website (www.MathsThroughStories.org). This was to coincide with the World Book Day celebration on that same day.

Dr. Trakulphadetkrai shared preliminary findings of his pilot research project that set out to explore the effectiveness of children creating their own mathematical picturebook on developing their conceptual understanding in mathematics. He also invited teachers and parents who were listening to the programme to visit the website which contains the world's largest on-line database of over 500 recommendations for mathematical stories.
